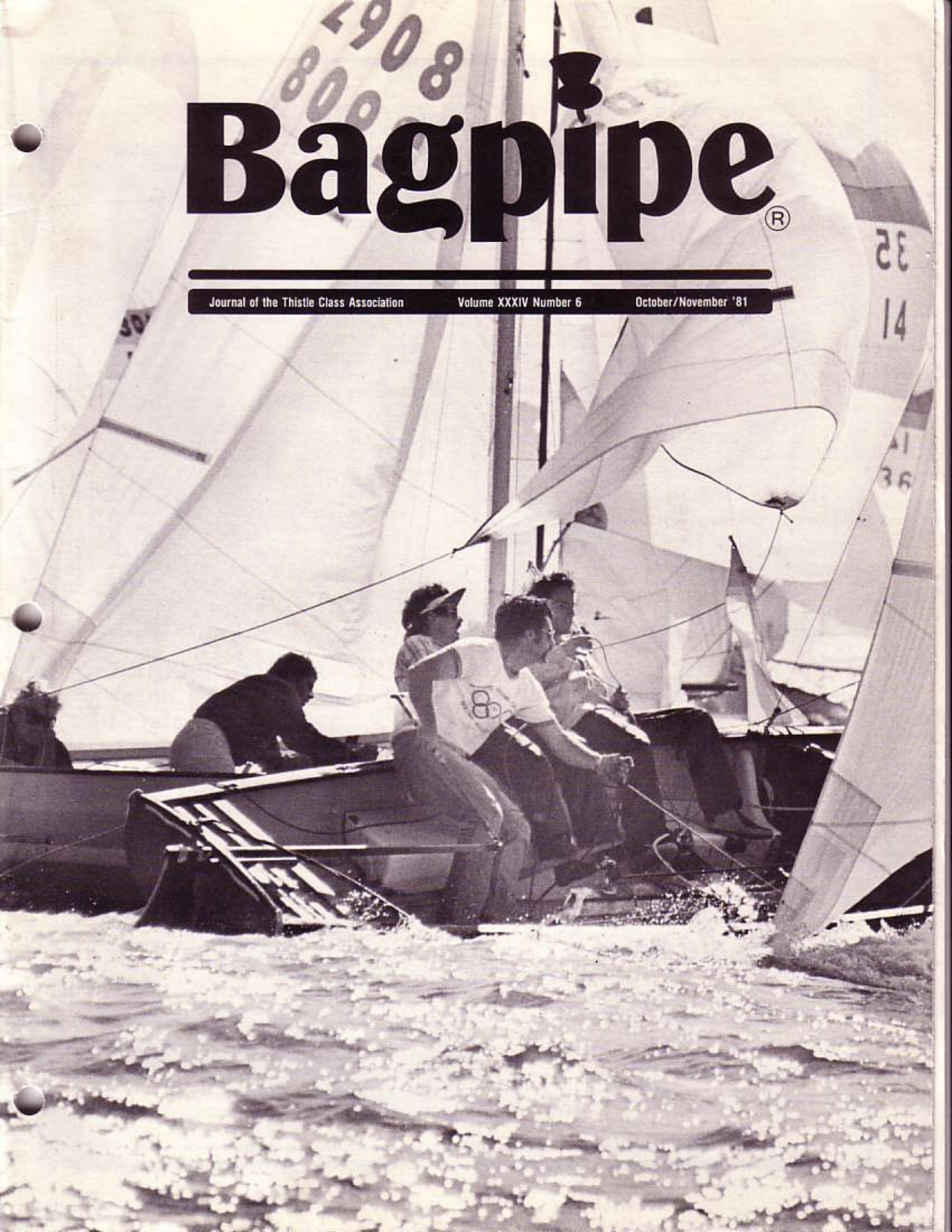

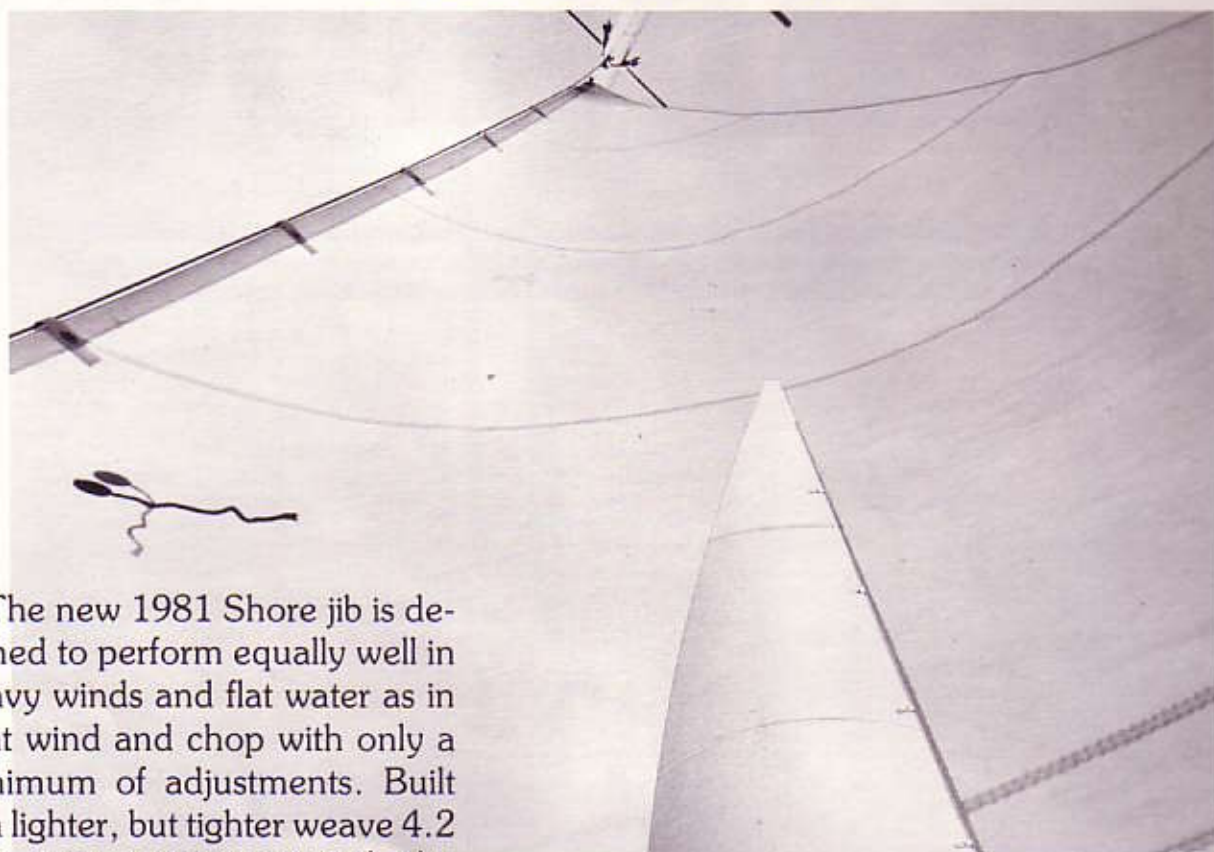

THE 1981 SHORE JIB



The new 1981 Shore jib is designed to perform equally well in heavy winds and flat water as in light wind and chop with only a minimum of adjustments. Built of a lighter, but tighter weave 4.2 new yarn temper material, the Shore jib is easy to read in drifters, but holds its shape in the heaviest of winds. Set your rig up tight, your jib halyard so slight wrinkles are showing off the luff and trim it so the leech is 2" off the spreader in all conditions except very light or very heavy winds. A special Shore tuning guide and window is included with every Shore jib. The new 1981 Shore jib is truly an all-around performer—ask any Shore customer.
